MINUTES OF THE VESTRY ST. PHILIP'S EPISCOPAL CHURCH JANUARY 14, 2024 @NOON

<u>Present</u>: Bill Burke – Senior Warden, Dick David – Junior Warden, Kelly Adams – Treasurer, Chad Espeland, Lester Hailey, Melinda Jackson, Lynda Jungkind, Elizabeth Lott, Lori McIntire, and Julia Young. Attendance represented that a quorum was present.

Not present: Susan Slaughter, and Betty Smithson.

Bill Burke opened the meeting with prayer, and the reading of our Mission Statement.

Vestry members checked in.

Budget discussion;2024 reflected a surplus of \$54,885.47. **Motion was made, seconded and unanimously approved** to accept the 2024 budget as presented out of Committee.

The Hoerner Fund should be more than a "cash cow". More discussion will take place at the Vestry Retreat.

Montessori utilities continue to go up at 47% more. More discussion to take place at the Vestry Retreat.

A search update was given — Bishop Seage met with the wardens, and the Search Committee members to advise that he was withdrawing the name of our potential candidate for rector. Back to the drawing board — we will persevere!

Discussion ensued regarding parish without an interim; possible short-term interim from Bishop Seage; Molly short-term; names mentioned as possible fill-in: David Johnson, Chip Davis, Andy Andrews; Jud Meadows, David Elliott; necessary to plan for each service; perhaps get each temp to commit to once a month for short period of time. The Senior Warden is working on it. It is not necessary for the Vestry to be frozen, since we no longer have a candidate for rector.

How do we reach those folks not seen; website needs cleanup; how do we handle McLeod; reactivate greeters; discuss outreach possibilities; Habitat houses.

Motion was made, seconded and approved to dispense with the reading of the Vestry minutes.

After brief discussion, motion was made, seconded, and unanimously approved to accept the minutes with two amendments: (1) paragraph four, after "rector arrives", add "according to the Bishop's agreement with St. Philip's"; and (2) delete the sentence beginning with "The new Vestry".

The Financial Report was presented that reflected a negative balance of approximately (\$22,993.45). Motion was made, seconded, and unanimously approved to accept the Financial Report as presented out of committee.

The meeting concluded with prayer at approximately 2:20 PM.
